VIRTUAL FACILITY, INC. PRIVACY POLICY

We at Virtual Facility, Inc. ("<u>Virtual Facility</u>," "<u>we</u>," "<u>us</u>," or "<u>our</u>") have created this privacy policy (this "<u>Privacy Policy</u>") because we know that you care about how information you provide to us is used and shared. This Privacy Policy relates to the information collection and use practices of Virtual Facility in connection with our website ("Site"), our mobile application ("App") and our online platform ("Platform") (collectively, the "Services").

By clicking "I AGREE," or otherwise manifesting your assent to the Privacy Policy and accompanying <u>Terms and Conditions</u> ("Terms"), when you visit or sign up to access and use the Services, you acknowledge that you have read, understood and agree to be legally bound by the terms of this Privacy Policy and the accompanying Terms.

Capitalized terms not defined in this Privacy Policy shall have the meaning set forth in our Terms.

The Information We Collect and/or Receive

In the course of operating our Services, and/or interacting with you, we will collect (and/or receive) the following types of information. You authorize us to collect and/or receive such information.

1. Contact Information.

When you sign up to use the Services, contact us using any of the variety of ways found in our "Contact Virtual Facility" tab, or request a demo of the Services, you may be required to provide us with personal information about yourself, such as your name, username, e-mail address, and job title (collectively, the "Contact Information"). 2. Other Information.

 - o Information about a mobile device, including universally unique ID ("<u>UUID</u>"), App type and version (e.g., iOS or Android), carrier and country location, hardware and processor information (storage, chip speed, camera resolution, NFC enabled, and network type (WiFi, 3G, 4G, 5G); and
 - Activity and usage information occurring via the App, including tagging data, session lengths; and similar data.

- b. <u>From Cookies</u>. We do not currently but may in the future collect information using "Cookies." Cookies are small files containing strings of characters that a website stores on your device so that the website will remember your browser. We may use session cookies, which expire once you close your web browser, to help us collect Other Information and to enhance your experience using the Website or App. If you do not want us to place a cookie on your device, you may be able to turn that feature off on your computer or mobile device. Please consult your Internet browser's documentation for information on how to do this and how to delete persistent cookies. However, if you decide not to accept cookies from us, the Website or App may not function properly.
- c. <u>Third-Party Analytics</u>. We may use one or more third-party analytics services to evaluate your use of the Services, compile reports on activity (based on their collection of IP addresses, Internet service provider, browser type, operating system and language, referring and exit pages and URLs, date and time, session and page duration, what sections of the Services you visit, number of links clicked while on the Services, search terms and other similar usage data), and analyze performance metrics. These third parties use cookies and other technologies to help analyze and provide us the data. By accessing and using the Services, you consent to the processing of data about you by these analytics providers in the manner and for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy. How We Use and Share the Information

You authorize us to use the Contact Information, Geolocation Information and Other Information (collectively, the "<u>Information</u>") to provide you the Services, solicit your feedback, inform you about our products and services and to improve our Services.

You also authorize us to use and/or share your Information as described below.

- <u>Agents, Providers and Related Third Parties.</u> We may engage other companies and individuals to perform certain business-related functions on our behalf. Examples may include providing technical assistance, customer service, and marketing assistance. These other companies will have access to the Information only as strictly necessary to perform their functions and to the extent permitted by law. - <u>Your Employer</u>. If you have received access to the Services through your employer, we may share your Information with your employer in the form of reports, dashboards, and other means.
